

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

The following materials will NOT be collected:

- Wire-spring mattresses and bed bases
- Oil heaters
- Commercial, trade, industrial or shop waste, eg. plumbing fixtures, water tanks and tiling
- Tyres, wrecked motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts and engines
- Building and demolition materials, concrete, bricks and panes of glass
- Household hazardous waste, eg. paint, spray paint, asbestos, solvents, chemicals, cleaners and unwanted medicines
- Lengths of material longer than 1.8m (excluding lounges etc)
- Small machinery containing fuel or oil
- Liquids of any sort including fuel and oil
- Batteries and gas bottles
- Recyclables collected in the yellow lidded bin, household garbage, and food scraps
- Garden organics, timber, grass clippings, soil and stones
- Treated timber, tree stumps and heavy branches
- Hot water systems larger than 260 litres
- Glass, windows or sliding doors that contain glass
- Fencing wire

COLLECTION ZONES

Place waste out 2 days prior.

Zone 1: 29 June - 6 July Hallidays Point, Diamond Beach, Black Head, Red Head, The Lakes Way to Pacific Hwy inc Rainbow Flat, Chelmsbrook Est, Koorainghat, Half Chain Rd (Sthn side of creek to Godfrey Hill Rd), Possum Brush. Former GTCC Shire residents of Nabiac, Wang Wauk, Bunyah, Dyers Crossing, The Bucketts Way to the boundary at Belbora.

Zone 2: 7 - 13 July Old Bar, Wallabi Point, Bohnock, Oxley & Mitchells Island, Manning Point, Glenthorne, Pampoolah, Half Chain Rd (Nthn side of creek to Old Bar Rd), Purfleet, Forest Downs Est, Tinonee, Tinonee Rd to Bight Bridge, Mondrook, Bootawa, Bull Hill Rd, Killawarra, Kimbriki, Burrell Creek, Dollys Flat, Karaak Flat, Mt George area up Nowendoc Rd to Rocks Crossing Reserve and side roads.

Zone 3: 14 - 21 July Harrington, Crowdy Head, Moorland, Johns River, Hannam Vale, Waitui, Cooperook, Moto, Croki, Jones Island, Langley Vale, Lansdowne, Upper Lansdowne, Yarratt Rd, Lansdowne Rd including Melinga, Oakvale Rd, Clovernook Est, Kundle Kundle and Brimbin Rd to Taree Airport.

Zone 4: 22 - 28 July All of Cundletown Village, Dumaresq Island, Chatham (eastern side of railway line between racecourse and Browns Creek underpass and from the underpass to Crescent Ave).

Zone 5: 29 July to 6 August Taree North to Wingham Rd (western side of railway line between the Racecourse and Browns Creek underpass and from the underpass to Victoria St), Taree, Taree Estate, Taree West, Wingham Rd to Bushland Dr and Bushland Estate.

Zone 6: 7 - 14 August Kolodong District, Wingham Rd from Bushland Dr to Wingham, Woola Rd, Cedar Party Rd full length and estates, Youngs Rd, Wingham township, Comboyne Rd to Killabakh, Strathcedar, Moorall Creek, Bulga Rd from Wingham to Bobin, Marlee, Wherrol Flat, Caparra and Elands.

2020 scrap metal and BULKY WASTE CLEAN-UP

Check inside for important information about what will be accepted, and how to prepare your waste to ensure our contractors will collect it.

The scrap metal and bulky waste clean-up is available to all MidCoast Council residents who currently receive a domestic waste and recycling collection service.

GUIDELINES

Preparing your waste for collection

Before you start putting items out for collection, please note the following:

Can it be re-used? Think about neighbours and friends, try selling via an online service such as Gumtree, or hold a garage sale.

Is it sorted? Sort waste into two separate piles - one for scrap metal/whitegoods, and one for general and electronic waste.

Will it fit into a trailer? Your total load must fit into a standard (7'x4') box trailer (2 cubic metres)... if not, it won't be picked up.

Is it manageable? Individual items must not exceed 30kg.

Is it secure? To avoid windblown littering, loose items must be tied securely into bundles with rope or string (not wire), or contained in sturdy boxes (no plastic bags).

Is it in the way? Your waste must be placed neatly on the kerb or roadside where your bins are normally collected, and should not obstruct the footpath or roadway.

Is it on time? Place your waste out 2 days prior to pick-up, as our trucks will not return later to collect it. No earlier, or this is considered illegal dumping and you could be fined.



What is accepted? Check the list opposite for what will be accepted. Contractors will not sort through your piles, so one unacceptable item may mean your entire pile is not collected.

Any unacceptable items that are not collected when the pickup finishes in your zone must be removed within 24 hours (penalties apply).

Waste items not accepted in the bulky waste clean-up can be disposed of at your nearest Waste Management Centre. Fees apply depending on the type and volume of waste.

Free mattress disposal during clean-up:

A maximum of two wire-spring mattresses or one mattress and bed base per household can be dropped off for free at your nearest Waste Management Centre between 29 June and 14 August 2020.

Free all year round:

Household quantities of paint, oil, gas bottles, batteries, smoke detectors, fluoro globes, electronic waste and fire extinguishers can be disposed of for free at any time.



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Materials must not exceed
2 cubic metres in total

Scrap metal and white goods

All metal items will be recycled

- Fridges* and washing machines*
- Microwaves*
- Metal push lawn mowers (no fuel or oil) and wheelbarrows
- Empty paint tins (lids removed)
- Stoves
- Clothes dryers*
- Barbecues
- Pushbikes
- Hot water systems (less than 260 litres)
- Metal furniture

* Doors must be removed from household appliances and whitegoods

General waste and electronic waste

All general bulky waste will be landfilled

- Eskies
- Furniture / chairs
- Bric-a-brac
- Lounges (that comply with size limit)
- Floor coverings
- Vacuum cleaners
- Pottery and ceramics
- Small appliances
- Tables
- Foam mattresses (no springs)
- e-Waste, including items such as computers, TV's, VCRs, stereos, copiers, faxes and mobile phones
