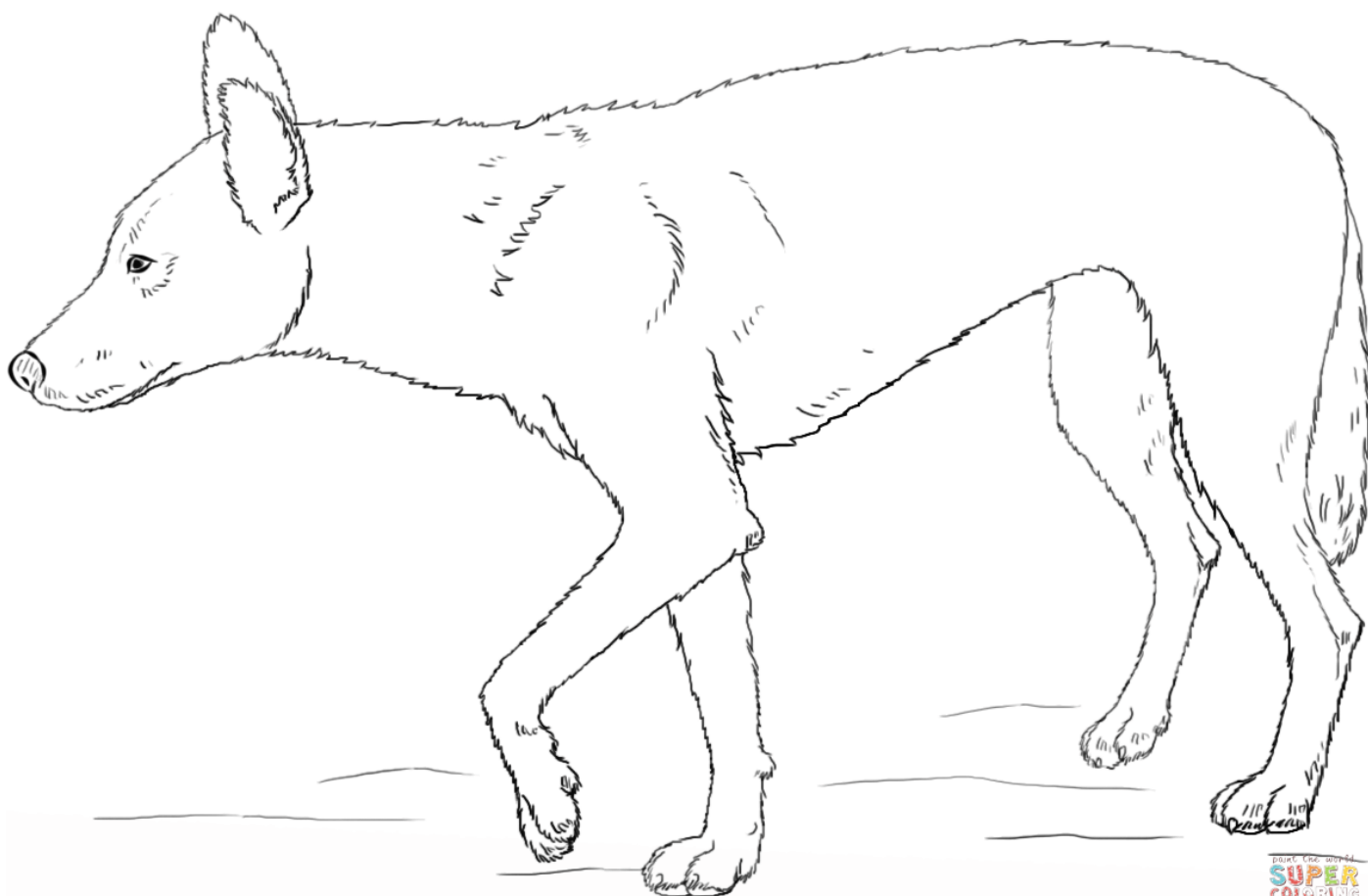




Dingo facts
