4. SEVERE RESTRICTIONS
No outside use, essential indoor use only

There is a total ban on all outdoor water use

Residential

Only use recycled or grey water on gardens.

No sprinklers or garden irrigation systems.

No car or boat washing.

No swimming pool top-ups.

Save water inside too!

While not part of Level 4 restrictions, please be water-wise and consider how you can save water indoors too!

- Check you have no dripping taps or plumbing leaks.
- Run full loads of washing, or adjust the water level on the washing machine.
- Limit showers to 2 -3 minutes.
