Notice of intended pesticide application

We have instructed Local Pest Experts to carry out pesticide applications in the Manning Region during November - January.

Pesticides are being used for spiders, cockroaches and ants and will be applied to Council structures including public buildings.

Pesticides used will be selected from the following products: Biflex Aquamax insecticide, Synergy Pro ant bait, Stardust Pro, Maxforce Gold Gel, Enviromax Deltamethrin, Temprid 75 and Termidor.

Residents (including pets) are advised not to enter the structures through any treated areas until the pesticides used have dried, or any special instructions advised on the notice erected on the day(s) of treatment.
