Upcoming works: **QUEEN STREET, GLOUCESTER**



Important road reconstruction works in Queen Street, between Church and Barrington Streets, are scheduled to begin later this month and will continue through to August, weather-permitting.

Along with reconstructing the worn road pavement, this phase of the project includes addressing the steep cross-fall to the kerb, footpath reconstruction, installation of a median strip and access ramps, drainage upgrades and construction of a roundabout at the Barrington Street intersection.

The project schedule has been designed to minimise disruption in this busy part of Gloucester, and will be conducted over three distinct phases:

- **In stage 1**, one-way access from Barrington to Church Street will be provided while work is undertaken on the northern side of Queen Street
- **In stage 2**, one-way access from Church to Barrington Street will be provided while work is undertaken on the southern side of Queen Street
- **In stage 3**, Queen and Barrington Streets will be closed to through-traffic, to allow for the construction of a roundabout at this intersection.

Clearly marked detours will be in place to direct motorists (see over for details).

We will work with businesses and residents to maintain driveway access during each stage of construction. Pedestrian access to businesses and residences will also be maintained throughout the construction period, with diversions in place at times as required.

Please note: To maintain a safe construction zone, on-street parking will be unavailable on Queen Street for the duration of stages 1 and 2 (parking in side-streets is available at any time).

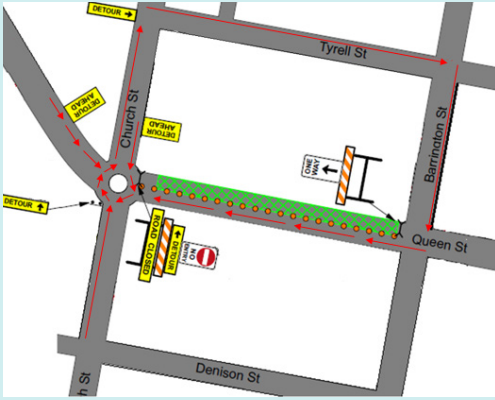

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Stage 1A: w/c 18 May

Work will commence with a one-day temporary closure on the southern side of Queen St, allowing for this side of the street to be prepared for single-lane access.

Stage 1B: w/c 18 May - early July



Work will take place on the northern side of Queen Street.

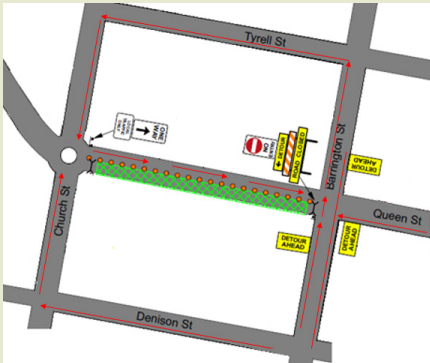
Single-lane access will be provided on the southern side for traffic travelling west.

The road will be closed to east bound traffic, with detours in place.

Pedestrian access will be available on both sides, at times with diversions in place on the northern side

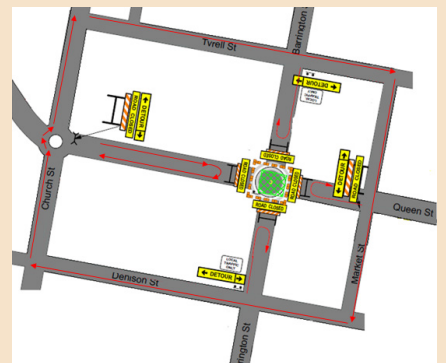
Driveway access for properties will be maintained but no on-street parking will be available on either side.

Stage 2: early July - end July



Work zone moves to the southern side of the street, with single lane access provided for east bound traffic.

Stage 3: end July - early August



Queen and Barrington Streets are closed for installation of roundabout. Driveway accesses remain open.

Completion: early - mid August

Finishing touches such as asphalt overlay, linemarking, turfing and restoration works may require intermittent lane or road closures during the final part of the project.
