	Some people are scared to report koala sightings as think there will be consequences if reported, e.g. can't build a house. This is not correct. The koala sightings are only used to update koala maps.
	Potential to utilise emergency service volunteer sightings (RFS, SES), develop an information sheet for volunteers on what to look for when doing hazard reduction, controlled burns, etc.
	Collateral could be taken to Peter's bushfire preparedness workshops

4 Red Cross Youth Disaster and Climate Resilience Project; Ana Mortimer, Project Officer - Youth Disaster & Climate Resilience Project, Australian Red Cross. Ana will be looking to engage young people, particularly high schoolers in the MidCoast area in disaster and climate resilience projects. The group discussed possible entry points for this project: Offering the development of practical and life skills, e.g. how to use a CB radio, basic firefighting skills through TAFE. Potential for Ana to engage with Police for community outreach. **Humour doctor** Try the army, navy, air force, RFS cadets, schools with Duke of Ed programs. RFS community engagement officers at individual brigades (Kerrie Guppie at Wallaby Joe) Peter's Simtable program could be used to show disaster simulations for youth. Kids on/at Oxley Island, Mitchells Island, Manning Point can contribute by reporting on local conditions, give them an opportunity to do something that is of value to their community. Kids with experience can show others that are new to the area. Kids love tictoc videos. Could one be produced advising on what you must do be bushfire prepared. Or other short form, online media? Daniel could connect Ana with TAFE teacher. Asking LLS what do people want. Unresolved resilience and recovery issues in your community(ies) Killabakh (see actions)- people still not understanding what their responsibilities are around preparedness (need fire fighting pump and at least 10,000 I water) Worries about upcoming bushfire season 6 NSW Recovery Plan up for review: https://www.nsw.gov.au/sites/default/files/2021-04/Supporting-Plan-Recovery.pdf
