BACK-TO-SCHOOL Road Safety

With the new school term starting, make sure you know the rules that are in place to keep our kids safe during school drop-off and pick-up times.

- Slow down to 40km/h when school zone signs and bus lights flash
- Look out for children crossing the road near bus stops, in school zones, and along bus routes
- Give way to buses as they merge back into traffic
- Observe kerbside signs showing where you can
 and can't stop your car in school zones



NEED TO REMOVE A TREE IN Your Backyard?

Sometimes trees can cause issues such as roots blocking drains, or overhanging branches posing a risk to people and property. In some cases, you may consider removing or pruning undesirable or dangerous trees or vegetation.

Before you do anything, make sure to check if a permit application is required based on your location.

VEGETATION MANAGEMENT CONTROLS

In some areas, controls are in place to ensure we balance the protection of the environment and landscape with the need to manage trees and other vegetation that are causing issues.

These protection controls differ from place to place, depending on the ecological value of the area - so one size does not fit all.
